SENTENCE

1. I have considered the mitigation and the fact that the accused is a first offender and aged 43 years, is remorseful, is the sole bread winner of his family and that he has been in custody for 4 years.
2. The court takes cognizance of the sentencing policy guidelines and the principles of sentencing espoused in *Francis Karioko Muruatetu & another v Republic* [2017] eKLR case.
3. I hereby exercise discretion and sentence the accused person to serve 25 years' imprisonment, calculated from the date of arrest.
4. Right of appeal to the Court of Appeal is explained, 14 days of today.
5. File closed.
