**RULING**

1. The convict was fined Kshs 10,000 in default to serve six months imprisonment on 9<sup>th</sup> July 2024 for the offence of conveying suspected stolen property contrary to section 323 of the [Penal Code](#).
2. He has served sentence as there is no evidence that he paid the fine.
3. The sentence review is overtaken by events.
