RULING

1. I have considered the Probation officer's report filed herein as ordered by the court. I also note that, although the applicant's sentence is lawful, the applicant is a first offender. The sheep he stole was recovered. It was valued at Kshs 13,000. He has been in custody for 8 months. In my opinion the applicant has learnt his lesson. I therefore direct that, the applicant be released on probationary services for a period of two (2) years from the date of this order. If he commits any other offence while on probation, he shall serve the remaining period in custody.
