RULING

1. The Applicant was convicted on his own plea of guilty of the offence of assault causing actual bodily harm contrary to section 251 of the [Penal Code](#). The trial court sentenced him to serve 1-year imprisonment. The Applicant has already served 3 months of his sentence in custody. The Probation Report by Ng'etich Nicholas Kibet, the Probation Officer filed on June 14, 2023 does not recommend a non-custodial sentence. In the premise, I direct that the Applicant continues to serve the remaining part of his sentence in custody.
