RULING

1. The Applicant does not disclose in clear terms whether he is seeking leave to appeal out of time or for Sentence Review.
2. The application dated July 12, 2023 cannot be considered on its merits in the absence of clarity on what the applicant/convict Victor Otieno Ogolla is seeking.
3. The application is struck out for vagueness. The Convict is at liberty to file a fresh clearer application stating what specific orders he is seeking from this court.
