The *Ex Parte* Applicant herein, **JAMES MURIUKI NGATIA**, has applied by **chamber summons dated 15/07/2021** under **Order 53, Rules 1, 2 & 3** of the ***Civil Procedure Rules, 2010*** for leave of the court to apply for judicial review. The relief to be sought is an order of ***mandamus*** to compel the Attorney-General of the Republic of Kenya to satisfy the decree in ***Nanyuki, CMCC No 14 of 2007***.
