**RULING**

1. The Applicant was charged and convicted on his own plea of guilty of the offence of stealing stock contrary to Section 278 of the *Penal Code* Cap 63 (Laws of Kenya). He was sentenced to serve twelve (12) months imprisonment on 23/12/2021. The same was to end on 23/8/2022 as per the early release date by prison. He declined to be interviewed for the community Service Orders. Be that as it may, taking into account the period of his arrest and date of sentence, in line with Section 333(2) of the *Criminal Procedure* Cap 75 (Laws of Kenya), the Applicant completed his sentence of 14/7/2022. It is hereby directed that the Applicant be and is hereby released from custody forthwith unless he be held for any other lawful cause. Orders accordingly.
