RULING

1. The Applicant was convicted on his own plea of guilty for the offences of assault causing actual bodily harm contrary to Section 251 of the *Penal Code* Cap 63(Laws of Kenya). She was also charged with the offence of child neglect contrary to Section 127(1) (a) of the *Children's Act* No. 8 of 2001. On October 26, 2021, she was sentenced to two (2) years which was to run from 29/4/2021. The same is to end on 29/8/2022. The Report by Peter Mogusu Ayienda Probation/ Community Service Officer that was filed on 1/8/2022 has recommended that she serves the remaining two (2) months on community service order at Ngenyi's Chief's Office. I hereby direct that the Applicant serves the community service order as recommended but until 29/8/2022. Orders accordingly.
