RULING

1. The applicant was charged with the offence of destroying cultivated produce contrary to Section 334(1) of the [Penal Code](#) Cap 63 (Laws of Kenya). He was convicted on his own plea of guilty and fined Ksh 200,000/- in default to serve three (3) years imprisonment on 15/9/2021. His early date of release by prison is 15/9/2023. He declined to be interviewed. The Court hereby leaves his sentence undisturbed. Orders accordingly
