RULING

1. The Applicant was charged with the offence of dealing with alcoholic drinks without licence contrary to Section 7(1) (b) as read with Section 34(a) of the *Alcoholic Drinks Control Act* No. 4 of 2010. He was arrested on 20/1/2022 and arraigned in court on 21/1/2022 when he pleaded guilty and was fined Kshs. 70,000/= or in default to serve one (1) year imprisonment. His early date of release by prison is 21/9/2022. I hereby direct that he serves the remaining period until 21/9/2022 under community service order at Riakimai Primary School as has been recommended in the Report of Edwin Kimaiyo Probation/community service Officer that was filed on 1/8/2022. Orders accordingly.
