RULING

1. The applicant with his co-accused were charged with the offence of burglary contrary to section 304(2) and stealing contrary to section 279(b) of the Penal Code cap 63(Laws of Kenya). He was arrested on 2/3/2021 and arraigned in court on 4/3/2022 when he admitted to the charges. He was sentenced to one (1) year imprisonment on 9/3/2022. Taking into account section 333(2) of the Criminal Procedure Code cap 75 (Laws of Kenya), his sentence ought to run until 30/10/2022. I hereby direct that the applicant be and is hereby released from custody to serve community service order until 30/10/2022 at Miriri health Centre, Miriri as has been recommended in the report of Samuel Chuma, Probation/Community Service Officer that was filed on 1/8/2022. Orders accordingly.
