RULING

1. The appellant was charged with the offence of causing grievous harm contrary to section 234 of the *Penal Code* Cap 63 (Laws of Kenya). He was sentenced to three (3) years imprisonment on 5/10/2022. His early release date as per the Prison is 5/10/2022. He had served about one (1) year, and nine (9) months and four (4) days. It is hereby directed that the applicant serves the remainder of his sentence under Community Service Order at Nambale Township Chiefs office as has been recommended in the Report of Austine Adewa Probation/Community Service Officer that was filed on 29/7/2022.
