**RULING**

1. The Applicant was charged with the house breaking contrary to Section 304 (1) (a) of the [Penal Code](#) Cap 63 (Laws of Kenya). He was sentenced to six (6) months imprisonment on 27/4/2022. The early release date by the Prison was 27/7/2022. This court finds the same to be 27/8/2022. In the Report of Joyce Achieng Odhiambo Probation/Community Service Office that was filed on 29/7/2022 indicates that the Applicant does not want to be considered for a non-custodial sentence and wishes to complete the sentence. Accordingly, his sentence be and is hereby left undisturbed. Orders accordingly.
