**RULING**

1. On September 28, 2022, the prosecution closed its case after calling a total of eight (8) prosecution witnesses.
2. The parties did not file any written submissions on the question of whether or not the accused person had a case to answer.
3. Having carefully considered the evidence by the prosecution witnesses, the court was of the opinion that a *prima facie* case had been established against the accused person herein to warrant him being put on his defence. He is hereby put on his defence.
4. It is so ordered.
