RULING

1. On 8/12/2022, the convict Ian Joseph Sangiwa was sentenced to serve 30 days imprisonment for possessing *changaa* to wit, two (2) litres.
2. He has served 15 days as he was arrested on 7/12/2022. He pleaded guilty.
3. As the convict is not a manufacturer and the quantity was little, I consider him a petty offender. I hereby revise the 30 days imprisonment and order that Ian Joseph Sangiwa be released from prison unconditionally, forthwith, unless otherwise lawfully held.
4. File closed. I so order.
