**RULING PURSUANT TO SECTION 210 OF THE CRIMINAL PROCEDURE CODE**

I have evaluated the prosecution evidence on record.

A daughter of the deceased PW1 testified to have been present on the fateful day, the 21<sup>st</sup> February 2015 when the accused, her brother and another brother who is at large hit their father on the head with a walking stick and dragged him into the house when he was bleeding profusely.

The alleged murder weapon was recovered at the scene. I find that the evidence by the prosecution witnesses to be sufficient to call upon the accused to defend himself and answer to the charges.

It is so ordered.
