**R U L I N G**

- 1. Kanchoro Kalamso Kabiro**, the Applicant is charged with the offence of **Murder**. He seeks to be released on **bail pending trial**.
- The application is premised on grounds that he is innocent until proven guilty; a resident of **Kalalani** in **Woldhenna sub-location** where he lives with his **two (2) wives** and **ten (10) children**, three of whom are adopted. The family depends on him and he is not a flight risk. He swore an affidavit in support of the application.
- Mamba Vincent**, learned counsel, for the state filed an affidavit in reply where he asked the court to grant stringent conditions of bail but he did not oppose his release on bail.
- I have considered the application which is not opposed. This means that there are no reasons that should cause the accused person's continued incarceration. In the premises, I grant him bond of **Ksh.1,000,000/-** with a surety in an even sum.
- It is so ordered.
