**RULING**

1. On 16<sup>th</sup> May 2015, three accused persons herein applied for variation of the bond terms to manageable and affordable level.

2. In a ruling read on 28<sup>th</sup> day of March 2012 the court gave bond to the three accused persons on the following terms:

**i) Each of the 3 accused persons shall be released on a personal bond of Ksh.500,000/= plus two sureties of the like amount to be approved by the Deputy Registrar of this honourable court.**

**ii) Each of the 3 accused persons shall report to the police at Chepilat Police Station once a month w.e.f. 27<sup>th</sup> April 2012 until their case is heard and determined or until further orders of this honourable court.**

**iii) Each accused person shall also appear before this Honourable Court for mention of their case once a month w.e.f. 10<sup>th</sup> May 2012 until this case is heard and determined or until further orders of this court.**

3. In view of the application, above, for variation of bond terms, this court will reduce the sureties from two to one surety each.

4. It is so ordered.
