RULING

1. The accused application to be released on bail in unopposed by the State. That means there are no compelling reasons known to the State to deny the accused bail.
2. Bail is therefore granted on the following terms:
 - a. Accused may deposit cash bail in the sum of KShs.50,000/= for her release.
 - b. In the alternative accused may sign a bond of KShs.200,000/= with one surety of like sum.
 - c. No reporting to any police station or mention in court is required in this case.
