RULING

The certificate of confirmation of grant issued on 3rd February, 2011 is hereby amended so that the following properties shall be re-distributed:

- (I) Githunguri/Ikinu/146 shall be divided into seven (7) equal portions and inherited by the seven children of the deceased save for John Muritu Muhinja and Teresa Wangare Gatumbi.
- (II) The house where the widow of the deceased resides together with the portion of land surrounding it shall be inherited by Pauline Wairimu Muhinja.
- (III) LR. No. Githunguri/Riuki/T.116 shall be inherited in equal shares by the seven beneficiaries of the deceased save for John Muritu Muhinja and Teresa Wangare Gatumbi.
- (IV) In the event of any dispute concerning the other properties of the deceased, the affected beneficiary shall be at liberty to apply.
