J U D G M E N T

1. I have perused the record and I am satisfied that the pleas was unequivocal.
2. He asked the Court to be lenient on him and release him to go and look after his children.
3. The learned trial Magistrate called for a Probation Officers Report before sentence. The report came and it showed that the appellant has been antagonizing his family members by beating them up and issuing them with threats though no reports were being made.
4. The record shows he was convicted and sentenced on 11/1/2012, for three (3) years. With remission he ought to have completed sentence. Its therefore not clear why he is still in Prison. Be as it may, I find no merit in his appeal which I hereby dismiss.
