DIRECTIONS/ORDER

Having heard the parties and considering the best interest of the Child **B. G. N**, I hereby direct as follows;

- (1) **B.G.N** “the student” shall be permitted to enter St. Nicholas Senior School only for the purpose of sitting for the Form 3 end of year exams and the school shall administer to the student all the form three end of year examinations.
- (2) The student shall only be permitted to enter the school for purposes only of sitting the exams and shall leave immediately after sitting the examination.
- (3) The student shall not be permitted to have contact with any other students during the period of exams.
- (4) Subject to the aforesaid, the student shall not be permitted to enter into the school premises until further orders of the court.
