JUDGEMENT

There is judgement entered in this suit leaving only the assessment of damages.

According to the medical report the plaintiff suffered the following injuries as a result of the accident.

- (1) Head injuries and was unconscious for 4 days
- (2) Whip-lash injury of the neck
- (3) Burnt chest injury
- (4) Dislocated right elbow point
- (5) Severe blunt injury to lumbo sacral spine and right hip joint
- (6) Severe blunt injury to the right shoulder
- (7) Sprained right knee joint.

She complained of poor memory and headaches.

In support of what damages should be paid for these injuries each side cited cases for companion.

I have compared the injuries in these cited cases with the plaintiffs injuries and I decided that a sum of Shs.350,000/- shall be adequate compensation.

There will be judgement for the plaintiff for the sum of Kshs.350,000/- and Kshs. 1,300/- as special damages.

The Plaintiff shall have the cost of the suit and interest.
