RULING

1. The Applicant was convicted for the offence of cheating contrary to Section 315 of the [Penal Code](#). The trial court sentenced her to pay a fine of Kshs. fifty thousand (Kshs. 50,000/=) or to serve four (4) months imprisonment in default. The Applicant has served two (2) weeks of her sentence and is remaining with three (3) months to complete the sentence. The Sentence Review Report filed on 5th March 2025 by the Probation Officer Mr. Nelson Maroa recommends a non-custodial sentence. I hereby direct that the Applicant shall serve a Community Service Order for three (3) months at Nyamira Probation Office under the supervision of the Probation Officer Nyamira. She will also undertake a short guidance and counselling program facilitated by the Probation Office during that period.

Orders accordingly.
