RULING

2. The Applicant was convicted on her own plea of guilty for the offence of manufacturing alcoholic drinks without a license contrary to Section 27 (1) (a) as read with Section 27 (4) of the [Alcoholic Drinks Control Act](#) No 4 of 2010. The trial court sentenced her to pay a fine of Kshs. thirty thousand (Kshs 30,000/=) or to serve three (3) months' imprisonment in default. The Applicant has served two (2) weeks of her sentence and is remaining with two (2) months after remission, to complete the sentence. The Sentence Review Report filed on 5th March 2025 by the Probation Officer Mr. Nelson Maroa recommends a non-custodial sentence. I hereby direct that the Applicant shall serve a Community Service Order for two (2) months at Boisanga 1 Sub-Location Office under the supervision of the Probation Officer Nyamira and the Assistant Chief Boisanga 1 Sub-Location.

Orders accordingly.
