**RULING**

1. The accused was arraigned before this court charged with the offence of murder contrary to section 203 as read together with section 204 of the [Penal Code](#) (Cap 63) Laws of Kenya.
2. He pleaded not guilty to the charge and the prosecution case proceeded on. I have considered the evidence adduced by the prosecution at the close of its case and I am satisfied that, there is adequate evidence to place the accused on his defence. Therefore pursuant to the provisions of section 306 of the [Criminal Procedure Code](#) of Kenya, (Cap 75). I required the defence to indicate to the court how he will conduct his defence.
