**RULING**

1. The accused has applied to be released on bail pending his trial. The prosecution is not objecting to the release of the accused on bail. Bail is a constitutional right under Article 49 (i) (h). The right can only be denied should it be shown the existence of any compelling reasons. No such reason has been shown. I order that accused be released on bail on the following terms:-
  - i. A bond of Kshs500,000/= with one surety of a similar amount.
  - ii. An alternative of Kshs 100,000/= as cash bail.
  - iii. Accused is ordered not to interfere with any prosecution witness till this matter is determined.
  - iv. Upon release, he is ordered to attend court at all times till the case is determined.
