RULING

1. The convict Fredrick Ogor Kasera was convicted and sentenced to serve 15 years imprisonment for the offence of defilement contrary to section 8(1) (3) of the [Sexual Offences Act](#). It is not clear whether he appealed or not.
2. He is to complete his sentence on October 28, 2030 from October 29, 2015. He has served only 7 of the 15 years imprisonment.
3. I find the convict Fredrick Ogor Kasera not suitable at this stage for prison decongestion as he still has 8 years to complete the prison term.
4. I dismiss the application.
5. File closed.
