RULING

1. Upon going through the originating notice of motion and the supporting affidavit from the record dated April 3, 2023 it appears that the respondents were merely harassing the applicant and had no meaningful interest in investigating him.

I therefore order as follows:-

- a. A conservatory order is hereby issued restraining the respondents and their servants from arresting and or harassing the applicant.
- b. Should the respondent require the applicant to report to the police station, they shall give him sufficient notice to attend.
- c. The respondent is restrained from locking up the applicant before a decision to charge him has been made.
- d. Should such a decision be made, the applicant shall be informed and directed to appear in court for plea.
- e. File closed.
