RULING

1. The convict Wilstone Ekuttan was charged with the offence of assault causing actual bodily harm. He pleaded guilty and after conviction and mitigation considered, he was sentenced to a fine of Kshs.30,000 in default to serve 8 months imprisonment on 18th April 2024.
2. He has already served 7 months and is about to complete sentence on 18th December 2024.
3. In the spirit of prison decongestion, I order that the period served in prison is sufficient punishment.
4. Unless otherwise lawfully held, Wilstone Ekuttan is hereby released forthwith.
