RULING

1. The offender was fined Kshs.60,000 in default to serve 8 months imprisonment on 29th July 2024 and she has already served 4 months imprisonment for the offence of being in possession of 80 litres of alcoholic drinks to wit, changaa.
2. The presentence review report dated 15th March 2024 shows her to be remorseful. She has a family to fend for. Non custodial sentence, (CSO) is recommended at Ojolla Primary School.
3. I have considered the sentence review report filed on 18th November 2024.
4. In the spirit of prison decongestion, I hereby order that the convict shall be released from prison on the sentence served not that schools are on long recess. She should be warned not to reoffend.
