RULING

1. On 28th May 2024 the convict John Kiranya Njeli was sentenced to 18 months' imprisonment for the offence of stealing.
2. He is a recidivist, according to the Sentence Review Report filed on 18th November 2024 as he benefitted from non-custodial sentence for threatening to kill.
3. He is unsuitable for release on non-custodial sentence. He shall serve full term of the imposed prison term.
