RULING

1. On 6th March 2024, the convict Peterlis Opiyo Odhiambo was sentenced to serve 12 months' imprisonment for the offence of cultivating prohibited narcotics to wit, Bhang.
2. He pleaded guilty and pleaded for leniency. He has served 9 months of the 12 months' imprisonment. No presentence Report was filed.
3. In the spirit of prison decongestion, the convict Peterlis Opiyo Odhiambo is hereby ordered released from prison forthwith, unless otherwise lawfully held.
