RULING

1. On 28th May 2024, the convict Jacob Ochieng Odongo was sentenced to serve 2 years' imprisonment for the offence of stealing contrary to Section 275 of the [Penal Code](#). His co-accused Nicholas Odhiambo Owuor was sentenced to serve 2 years' probation. They pleaded not guilty. They stole 4 chicken valued at Kshs.2,400.
2. The convict herein is known to be a troublesome person in the community. He is 24 years old. He has served 6 months in prison.
3. In the spirit of decongestion, the convict Jacob Ochieng Odongo is hereby released to serve Probation the remainder of the 2 years imprisonment being 1 year and 6 months, to be counselled to stop stealing and earn from genuine work done.
