RULING

1. On 12th April 2024, the convict Rodgers Okoth was sentenced to a fine of Kshs.30,000 in default to serve one (1) year imprisonment for the offence of Burglary and Stealing. He pleaded guilty to the charge. He has already served 7 months in prison.
2. In the spirit of prison decongestion, unless otherwise lawfully held, the convict shall be released from prison on the sentence already served and warned not to reoffend.
