RULING

1. On 30th May 2024 the offender, Vincent Ochieng Okoth a 24-year-old was sentenced to serve 1 year imprisonment for the offence of housebreaking and stealing. The presentence report did recommend non-custodial sentence and the sentence review report dated 18th November 2024 does not recommend non custodial.
2. He has served 6 months of the 1-year prison term.
3. In the spirit of prison decongestion, the offender is hereby conditionally released from prison not to reoffend as he has no fixed abode.
4. Signal to issue.
