RULING

1. On 15th July 2024, the Convict James Otieno Okul was sentenced to serve 6 months' imprisonment for the offence of creating disturbance in a manner likely to cause breach of the peace.
2. He admitted the offence. He has served 7 months.
3. In the spirit of prison decongestion, I order that the offender James Otieno Okul shall be conditionally released from prison not to reoffend for the next 6 months and unless otherwise lawfully held, he is set at liberty forthwith.
4. Signal to issue.
