RULING

1. The convict Moses Owuor Okun has served one (1) year of the 18 months' imprisonment for uttering threatening to kill words towards the complainant.
2. The circumstances as described in the charge sheet and facts which he admitted were not violent. The convict shall benefit from prison decongestion not to reoffend.
3. Unless otherwise lawfully held, Moses Owuor Okun is hereby released from prison and the period served is considered sufficient punishment.
4. He should be warned not to reoffend.
5. Signal to issue.
