RULING

1. The Convict Fredrick Odhiambo Olero was sentenced to serve one (1) year imprisonment on 9th April 2024 for the offence of cutting down crops of cultivated produce. He is about to complete sentence.
2. In the spirit of prison decongestion, unless otherwise lawfully held, I order that the period of 7 months is sufficient punishment. He shall be released forthwith and warned not to reoffend.
