**RULING**

1. On 22<sup>nd</sup> July 2024 the offender Junior Moses Omollo alias Tyson was convicted of assault causing actual bodily harm and sentenced to a fine of Kshs.10,000 in default to serve 1 year imprisonment.
2. He used a chisel to cut the complainant. No presentence report was filed. He has served 4 months’ imprisonment and has 8 months remaining. He is the brother to the complainant.
3. In the spirit of prison decongestion, the offender is hereby released from prison unless otherwise lawfully held, on condition that he writes an apology letter to the complainant and promises not to reoffend.
4. Signal to issue. File closed.
