**RULING**

1. On 20<sup>th</sup> February 2024, the offender herein Isaack Ouma Onyango was sentenced to serve 3 years’ imprisonment for the offence of stealing a motorcycle. He denied committing the offence. He has served 10 months. The offence is serious.
2. In the spirit of prison decongestion, as there was no presentence report filed, I order the offender to serve probation for the remaining period of 1 year 2 months to be supervised by Probation Officer at Winam probation officer and in case of breach of probationary terms, the offender shall be rearrested and taken to prison to complete the remainder of the sentence imposed.
