RULING

1. The convict Willis Otieno was sentenced to serve 3 years imprisonment in default of a fine of Kshs.100,000 for grievous harm contrary to Section 234 of the [Penal Code](#).
2. The injuries suffered by the complainant are grave involving deep cuts and fracture of the hand and is unable to flex the hand. The convict was handed lenient 3-year term yet the maximum is life imprisonment.
3. There is no evidence of remorse and reform since he denied the offence.
4. The convict to serve full sentence imposed on 8th September 2023.
5. Signal to issue.
