**RULING**

1. The convict Felix Kwame Otieno was sentenced to serve 3 years’ imprisonment on 28<sup>th</sup> February 2023. He has served almost 2 years for offence of possessing stolen goods and is said to be well behaved according to the Sentence Review Report filed and dated 19<sup>th</sup> November 2024.
2. The probation officer recommends Community Service orders and the convict is willing.
3. The convict is hereby released from prison-on-prison decongestion exercise and shall perform unpaid Community Service at Lower Kachola Assistant Chief’s office for the remainder of the prison term, to be supervised by Kisumu Central Probation Officer.
