**RULING**

1. On 17<sup>th</sup> October 2023 the convict Victor Ouma was sentenced to serve 2 years’ imprisonment on two counts of breaking into a building and stealing. He pleaded guilty and was remorseful.
2. According to the presentence report filed in the lower court, he is said to be a known petty offender habitually, from the community’s comments. He has already served 1 year and one month.
3. In the spirit of prison decongestion, I hereby order the convict conditionally discharged and released from prison unless otherwise lawfully held and warned not to reoffend.
