**RULING**

1. On 25<sup>th</sup> March 2024, the convict Maurice Ouma was sentenced to serve 1 year imprisonment for the offence of possession of 26 litres of changaa. He pleaded guilty to the charge. He sought for forgiveness in mitigation. He has served 8 months' imprisonment.
2. In the spirit of prison decongestion, the convict Maurice Ouma is hereby conditionally discharged not to reoffend for the next 6 months.
3. Accordingly, unless otherwise lawfully held, the convict Maurice Ouma is hereby released from prison.
