RULING

1. On 14th May 2023, the convict Ramanus Obura Owele was sentenced to serve 2 years' imprisonment for the offence of stealing Motorcycle parts. This was through plea bargain.
2. He is a first offender. However, No presentence report was filed.
3. In the spirit of prison decongestion, as the offender has served 6 months already, he shall be conditionally released not to reoffend for the next 6 months and unless otherwise lawfully held, he is hereby forthwith set at liberty.
4. Signal to issue.
