RULING

1. On 24th August 2023, the convict John Okumu Owidi was sentenced to serve 2 years' imprisonment for the offence of Burglary and Stealing. He never appealed. He has served 1 year and 3 months.
2. In the spirit of prison decongestion, the convict John Okumu Owidi is ordered released from prison unless otherwise lawfully held and warned not to reoffend.
