RULING

1. The convict Bernard Wanyoike Wanjiku to serve full prison term imposed by the trial court as the complainant lost huge sums of money and there is no hope of recovering it from the dishonest criminal of the person of the convict herein.
2. No amount of remorse can heal the wound left following the pain of losing over Kshs 256,000 to a crook like the convict herein.
3. Refund be made before any sentence review in sought and considered.
4. Sentence revision is declined.
