RULING

1. On 13th June 2024, the convict Kefa Khaemba Wasike was sentenced to serve 18 months imprisonment in default of paying a fine of Kshs.50,000 for the offence of stealing by servant.
2. He has not paid the fine which is the equivalent of the amplifier property of his employer. The convict has already served 5 months of the period in default of a fine.
3. In the spirit of prison decongestion, noting that he was a first offender whose employer had not paid him a salary though not justifiable, and he pleaded guilty, I hereby order that the period served is sufficient and unless otherwise lawfully held, the convict Kefa Khaemba Wasike is hereby set at liberty and warned not to reoffend.
4. This file is closed.
