RULING

1. I have perused the affidavit of service dated 25th February 2021 and I am satisfied that both the defendants advocates on record and the defendant's Directors **Mr. Edwin Gichuki Kibe** and **Mr. Alfred Kibe Micah** were served with the Notice to Cross Examine the Defendants Directors.
